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

Hidden Gem in Costa Rica Gets Makeover

Nice Touch: An elevated spa has been built on pylons so as not to disturb the lush vegetation in one of the planet's most fragile ecosystems. The spa has four treatment rooms, two open-air massage rooms and two air-conditioned rooms. The treatment menu, which features a blend of the best in Asian and Latin American beauty and wellness techniques, includes the use of indigenous ingredients like volcanic mud, coffee and chocolate.

Hint: Nayara can arrange romantic dinners for two in a location of the guests' choice where there is a dedicated chef and service team to coordinate a special menu created especially for them.

Nayara can also arrange the unusual if guests should wish, such as a private, guided helicopter tour of the Arenal Volcano, touching down to explore the area and enjoy a private dinner with a dedicated chef and service team.
